

**ENR 5.6 BIRD MIGRATION AND
AREAS WITH SENSITIVE FAUNA**

1. Bird Migration

- 1.1 It has been observed that migratory birds in sizeable numbers appear on the aerodrome mostly during the period of winter months. Whilst the resident birds are presented in variable numbers every month.
- 1.2 The assessment on bird hazard is continually being carried out to assist in assessment of present deterrent measures and the planning of future activities.
- 1.3 The method to reduce the bird populations is to make the area unattractive to these birds and this is modification to the environment by closely cutting the grass and other plants.
- 1.4 All bird strikes on or in the vicinity of aerodromes and enroute shall be reported to the Airport Standards and Air Navigation Facilitating Division, Department of Civil Aviation 71 Soi Ngarmdu-Plee, Rama IV Road, Tung Mahamek, Bangkok Thailand 10120.
